Grass cutting in the Playing Field and Cemetery

The grass has recently been cut in the playing field and cemetery. Our Maintenance Workers close off these areas when the grass is due to be cut to ensure everyone's safety. If you see that the areas are closed off, please do not enter during the work in progress. Please note that the next dates for grass cutting are 17 and 31 May, and fortnightly thereafter. Both areas will be closed for a short time on both days, to enable the work to be undertaken safely.

Dogs in the Playing Field

Once again, just a reminder to everyone with a dog who uses the playing field area, that dogs are to be kept on leads at all times and are not permitted to run around without their leads, however inviting this may seem. We have had several complaints recently about dogs off of leads. Please also remember that Doggy Poo Bags are available from the Parish Council office FREE OF CHARGE, which avoids the problem of dog fouling, which has also been a problem recently. If everyone who uses the playing field could look after it, it will be a much better place for everyone.

St Dennis Parish Council – Feedback Form

Shortly, the St Dennis Parish Council will be preparing a Feedback Form to obtain residents' general feedback on how they feel the Parish Council helps the village.
